

Harold Sharp (1890-1980)

Harold Sharp worked for the Marylebone Spiritualist Association, now known as the Spiritualist Association of Great Britain (SAGB) for 25 years and is in our book of remembrance which is on view opposite the portrait of Mrs St. Clair Stobart (1862-1954).

On the first floor there are examples of his 'spirit art' known as 'auragraphs', which is a graph of the human aura using colour and intricate rhythmic designs. This process of automatic drawing and colouring was pioneered by Harold Sharp and his Spirit guide Chin Shih.

Harold Sharp also loved animals and wrote a book, *Animals in the Spirit World*, first published in 1966, in which he writes about moving accounts of reunions between animal spirits and their human friends.
