The Loving Power of Pray

Prayer, in its purest form is a great source of power.

I will quote here some words from the beloved spirit guide, Silver Birch.

'You can disregard all prayers that do not spring from a heart which is willing to serve and which is conscious of its obligations and duty. Having disregarded all those there are the prayers which because they are of psychic or spiritual exercise set into motion certain vibrations which bring responses.

Those responses are not necessarily the ones for which the man who makes the prayer expect. But they are the natural result of the vibrations he has created. If you have faith, honestly fairly and squarely all the problems and difficulties that beset you, if you have tried within the limits of your own power to find the solution and you have failed, then you have a perfect right to ask that some higher power some greater soul should give you light in your hour of need.

And you will get that guidance, you will get that light. For those who are round and about you, those who see with the eyes of the Spirit know the conditions of your own soul.

They know for example whether you are honest or not.'

Silver Birch's words may give us pause for thought upon how we ourselves feel when we pray. We may often feel our prayers haven't been answered and perhaps this is true in the way we had hoped but most of us will agree that when we pray deep in our hearts, we feel a sense of peace, of comfort, a sense that we are being listened to and that we are not alone.

There are those who have no definite spiritual or religious belief yet they admit to having resorted to prayer when faced with a desperate situation, even although they always regarded themselves as an atheist.

Who then are they praying to?

They embarrassingly admit they don't honestly know but just suddenly believe there has to be something out there, humorous yes but at the same time suggest that most decent people even those that deny believing in any divine force subconsciously do. Just at the time when they are on the brink of despair, some inner spiritual knowing calls them to prayer, because although the physical brain has denied God and Spirit, the Spirit mind knows the truth, it knows that love is at the centre of everything, and true prayer is a form of love.

Love that those we pray for and for the spiritual source, the God source which we trust instinctively can help them or ourselves.

When we pray for someone it is one of the highest forms of love. Whether on an emotional level for a family member, close friend or anyone in some way special to us. Or on an unconditional spiritual level for anyone in need worldwide.

True prayer is an inner knowledge of God and Spirit, it is more powerful than we know. It is the link between us and our spiritual home.

On behalf of our manager Karl and the trustees, our staff, mediums, healers and of course myself I thank you for joining us today and pray that we will all be physically reunited at our SAGB home as soon as faith allows.
